

Twelve ways in

Every effect a PDF can ask reading software for, one to a slide.

This file opens full screen, and each slide states how it arrives and how long it stands before the next one comes by itself. Reading software that honours all of it runs the whole thing unattended; one that honours none of it shows fourteen pages, and nothing is lost.

This first slide arrives by nothing at all: it is the one already on the screen.

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Split

Two lines sweep apart to reveal the slide.

the file states

/S /Split /Dm /V /M /O

Blinds

Many lines sweep across at once, like a blind opening.

the file states

/S /Blinds /Dm /H

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Box

A rectangle opens out of the middle of the slide.

the file states

/S /Box /M /O

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Wipe

One line sweeps left to right.

the file states

/S /Wipe /Di 0

Dissolve

The slide before it dissolves into this one.

the file states

/S /Dissolve

Glitter

The dissolve travels from the top-left corner down.

the file states

/S /Glitter /Di 315

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Fly

The slide before it flies off downwards.

the file states
/S /Fly /Di 270 /B true

Fly, at the reader

What has changed flies out of the screen, starting small.

the file states

/S /Fly /Di /None /SS 0.6 /B false

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Push

Both slides slide together, the old one pushing this on.

the file states
/S /Push /Di 180

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Cover

This slide slides up over the one before it.

the file states
/S /Cover /Di 90

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Uncover

The slide before it slides down off this one.

the file states

/S /Uncover /Di 270

Fade

The slide fades up out of reading software's own background.

the file states

/S /Fade

Replace

Nothing sweeps or fades: the slide is simply there.

the file states

/S /R
